- **Alumni:** Attend Alumni meetings Tuesday evenings and organize a fun informal alumni event.
- **Charitable Events:** organize various charitable events throughout the semester.
- **Financial Services:** Design and prepare official AA T-shirts/sweatshirts and contact firms for sponsorships.
- **Historian:** Attend AA events to take pictures and make a scrapbook at the end of the semester.
- **Membership:** Organize table sitting for the membership drive and throw a membership BBQ.
- **Publicity & Communications:** Create a newsletter and contact firms for newsletter sponsorships.
- **Social:** Fall directors in charge of organizing the Meet the Firms event. Spring directors help organize the Awards Banquet and Meet the Firms.
- **Special Events & Tours:** Organize firm tours and other firm related social events.
- **Student Development:** Organize the Resume Workshop and Mock Interview within the first month of the semester.
